**REMEMBER:**

- Give serious consideration to your **course choices (including options)**, as your timetable **WILL NOT** be changed. Timetable changes **will only** be made for students who have failed, do not have a pre-requisite or graduation requirement.
- Study the Course Description Guide carefully, especially the section on High School Diploma Requirements. This can be found on Bow Valley’s website.
- Consult your parents, teachers and school counsellor before making your choices.
- This is a registration request form. Your final program is **SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF COURSE AND THE APPROVAL OF THE ADMINISTRATION**. Since option courses may be cancelled due to insufficient enrolment, it is necessary to choose your courses carefully and list alternatives.
- Required Credit Load: Grades 10 & 11 = 40-42 credits and Grade 12 = minimum 30 credits. **Grade 10 & 11 students are not allowed spare periods** and therefore must choose enough courses to fill 8 blocks of time - see examples below. One 5-credit course fills one block of two terms, and one 3-credit courses fills one block of one term.
- **THE LEVEL OF MATHEMATICS, ENGLISH, SOCIAL STUDIES AND SCIENCE WILL BE BASED ON YOUR PREREQUISITE COURSE MARK. If you do not have the prerequisite mark, the computer will not let you register in the higher level course.**
