Player/Parent Agreement 2017 Season

Code of Conduct:

All participants in the Bow Valley Bobcat Football program are expected to sign a copy of and adhere to the Rocky View Sports Association code of conduct.

Equipment:

- All players are responsible for the proper care and return of all team equipment signed out. Players who fail to return or care for team equipment will be responsible for the replacement cost of the equipment.
- The only equipment players must purchase is a pair of cleats, and a girdle. All other required equipment will be loaned to players by the team.

Practice and Game Participation:

- Players are expected to attend all team meetings, practices, and games. Players who miss practice will not be prepared for games.
- > *Players who miss a meeting or practice for an unexcused reason will not play in the following game!
- > Excused absences are absences such as medical appointments or unavoidable circumstances.
- If missing practices or games is unavoidable players are expected to leave a message at the school with one of the team's coaches. (932-9005, ext. 8767) Telling a friend to tell let the coaches know is unacceptable.
- During the football season, total commitment is required from all players. Other extra curricular activities and jobs need to be scheduled around football commitments.
- > The coaching staff recognizes that academics should be the primary focus of all our players. However, players should not attempt to use schoolwork as an excuse to miss football commitments. If football is too large of a commitment for a player to be effective in their academics, they should not play football. Missing practice to work on homework is not considered an excused absence.
- Practices end at 5:30, giving players plenty of time for other commitments in the evening.

Fees: Fees for the 2017 season are \$550.00. This covers all transportation, equipment (except cleats and a girdle), and other costs the team incurs during a season. Generally, we take a \$200 deposit in the spring and collect the rest in September, as this tends to make the September payment less stressful.

Parent Meeting: We will be hosting a parent meeting to discuss the upcoming season and expectations of the players. We have a great fundraiser idea from one of our parents and we will need people to help this along. We will also need to discuss parent involvement in this upcoming season. The parent meeting will take place on Thursday, June 1st @ 5:30 in room 1023.

The Spring Football camp will begin on Monday, May 29^{th} after school until 5:30 each school day until Saturday, June 10^{th} .

We will have controlled scrimmage games on Saturday, June 3rd against Springbank on our turf field at 1-3 and Saturday, June 10th in Airdrie at Genesis Field (Not sure of the time yet).

Equipment pick-up will take place on Thursday, May 25th.
