



#### **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

To obtain an Alberta High School Diploma, students must meet these minimum requirements:

- Earn a minimum of 100 credits
- Complete and meet the standards of the following courses:
  - English 30-1 or 30-2
  - Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2
  - Mathematics 20-1 or 20-2 or 20-3
  - Science 20 or 24 or Biology 20 or Chemistry 20 or Physics 20
  - Physical Education 10 (3 or 5 credits)
  - Career and Life Management 20 (3 credits)
  - 10 credits from Career and Technology Studies, or Fine Arts, or
     Second Languages, or Physical Education 20 and/or Physical Education 30
  - 10 credits in any 30 level course in addition to English 30-1 or 30-2 and Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2, including 35-level Work Experience, or Advanced level Career and Technology Studies (3000 series)

In order to obtain an Alberta High School Certificate of Achievement, students must meet these minimum requirements:

- Earn a minimum of 80 credits
- Complete and meet the standards of the following courses:
  - English 20-2 or 30-4
  - Social Studies 10-2 or 20-4 or Science 24
  - Mathematics 10-3 or 20-4
  - Physical Education 10 (3 credits)
  - Career and Life Management 20 (3 credits)
  - 5 credits in  $\bullet$  30-level Knowledge and Employability occupational course, or  $\bullet$  30-level Career and Technology Studies (CTS) course, or  $\bullet$  30-level locally developed course with an occupational focus
  - -5 credits in 30-level Knowledge and Employability Workplace Practicum course, or 30-level Work Experience course, or 30-level Green Certificate course, or Special Projects 30

OR

5 credits in • 30-level Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) course

In order to obtain a Certificate of Completion, students must have attended High School for the full 3 years.

To be eligible to participate in BVHS Graduation Ceremony, all graduates need to be in good standing, this includes attendance, academics, citizenship, and school fees. The following conditions must be complied to;

- You are responsible to check the accuracy of your high school record of courses, marks and credits.
   Any questions regarding your high school record should be discussed with one of the Guidance Counselors.
- 2. If you lack credits in any compulsory grade 10 or 11 courses, you must be registered in, or be taking them in grade 12.

It is the <u>Graduates responsibility</u> to ensure that these requirements have or are being met!

When a student is removed from the grad list, they will NOT participate in the Graduation Ceremony.

#### **GRAD FEES & TICKETS**

This year's grad fees are \$110.00

The school-based fee covers the following:

- Gown, stole, memento cap and tassel purchase
- Facility/Item rentals
- Printing of programs etc
- Diploma Booklets & Certificates
- Incidentals cost that may be incurred

Starting Tuesday June 10th, 2025, Cap & Gowns along with 5 tickets per family will be issued. The graduate DOES NOT NEED a ticket. It will be up to each family to find more tickets if needed from other graduates.

•All GRAD fees must be paid in full - in order to pick up gown & tickets

**GRADUATION IS 100% USER PAY.** Any Graduate removed from the list after the Graduation fees have been paid will lose a portion of their payment.

If a student is removed from the grad list, the following refund policy applies:

The grad fee is based on the number of eligible grade 12 students on the grad list. Throughout the year, various items will be purchased or booked for each graduating student; therefore, it is necessary for each grad to be responsible for covering everything that has been bought for her/him up until the time she/he has been removed from the graduation list.

• The Graduation Committee has arranged for Lifetouch to be at the school from

Monday, Jan. 20<sup>th</sup> - Wednesday, Jan. 29<sup>th</sup> for photo sitting sessions. These sessions will open a few days at a time, once the first times are full, Lifetouch will open another few days as needed.

This site for booking opens December 20th, 2024. You can go to presitgeportraits.ca

- \*Each grad must have their picture taken at this time so that it will be in the composite and yearbook.
- Lifetouch will mail the proofs to the graduate's home. An email will be sent out with the password to view proofs.
- Orders can be placed online, through the mail or by phone.
- There is a \$40.00 sitting fee for the Grad picture pkg. There is NO charge to have a photo taken for the Yearbook/Composite picture. (Grad Class photo that hangs in the school hallways.)
- Cost of the photo packages varies depending on the package ordered.
- Graduates may bring props for their photo shoot such as a sport or music item. **NO PETS**.
- If you are not able to book a sitting at school, you can make an appointment to go into the Lifetouch studio.
- Retakes may also be taken by booking an appointment phoning 1-866-443-9648. The studio is at 3628 Burnsland Rd. SE Calgary.

Please ensure you have signed the AF144-A consent for public use of images form in School Engage, in order for your graduates' photo to be in the yearbook or in the composite. HANDSHAKE PHOTO: This is a complimentary photo, from <u>Lifetouch</u>, of the graduate receiving their diploma from Mr. Dempster at the graduation ceremony. Distribution of this photo will be decided upon at the end of the school year.


