- Welcome new parents
- Discuss Trustee role
- Trustees have had 1 board meeting- starting up school year, updates in schools reviewed
- Enrollment RVS- continues to grow- not as much as projected, Sept 30 cutoff for enrollment #'s for funding grants for year
- Strategic plan- finished year 3, starting year 4, report available for year 3 on website- 7 projects- anticipate opening 5 new schools in 5 years
- Changes to legislation- new forms to be filled out by parents possibly depending on student activities (female opt in sport etc.)
- Book bans- Minister requesting review of books available to students for visual graphics, noted RVS doesn't have many in place- more info to come in Jan.

- Question- Parent asking about plan if extended period of time away from school- noted plans will be created to support students

- Question- election- adding a trustee, how will this be handled? Oct 20th election, work will be divided between trustees- trustees to decide

- Expansion update- every day improvements are being made and deficiencies found, excitement for space from staff and kids, staff packed up everything before summer- shout out to them from Mr. Dempster, Spray Lakes for physical education classes- going well, gym next phase- gym shell up by Dec, Cosmo/band etc. in next phase, existing classrooms to get updates

- Question- do workers have a criminal background check? yes, sign in and out of office, currently about 12 workers on site only
