1. Call to Order

Meeting called to order by Valerie at 7:02pm

2. Guest Presentation – High School Redesign Initiative for Grade 9 (BVHS Staff)

- Teaching staff Mr. Ness, Mrs. Karlson and Mrs. Cholach explained that how the grade 9s will learn their cores will change next year
- Cores will be combined into a large block of time with students having fewer different teachers. Include wrap-around projects. Options accessible outside the core blocks
- Goal is to strengthen relationships and cross-curricular opportunities. Teachers will get to know students well due to lasting connections over time. Teachers will be able to collaborate closely with other teachers to be more effective teachers
- "Lines" that separate teachers and students will be "removed" which will improve relationships and increase a sense of community
- The teaching team that will instruct the Grade 9s will know what students need to know in future grades. This will ensure students are ready for grade 10
- Currently a team of 8 teachers are developing clear plans and learning objectives, determining assessment tools, and where to "house" the students
- Mr. Ness is the team lead and will teach grade 9 fulltime (Math/Science); Mrs. Karlson and Mrs. Cholach will teach Humanities; plus 5 other teachers involved

6. Old Business/Outstanding Items

i) On-Line Volunteer Form

- No new action taken. Plan to include some community and parent engagement that goes beyond traditional volunteer opportunities
- Will have form ready for September 2016 school year

7. Report from Bow Valley Administration

- Close to completing 2016-17 time table. Students will enter their time tables on-line soon
- Some teaching openings for next year. Conducting interviews in April
- Draft of SEP is complete. Will be presented to staff and school council
- Scholarship Committee has started reviewing portfolios. 14 applications received to date. Number of applications received is fewer due to more grade 12 students than usual taking a gap year next year
- Staff from Mitford, CCA & BVHS meeting by end of April to discuss transitioning of students
- April 28-30 "Beauty and the Beast" by Performing Arts students at Cochrane Ranche House
- May 6 Evening of Hope: "Hope Takes Flight". Airport theme. Kimmett Foundation will be the recipient of funds raised
- Have started planning Blue & Gold celebration (beginning of June)

8. Report from the Board of Trustees

- \$2.2 million budget surplus in 2015-16 across RVS \$1.4 million allocated to furniture and equipment in older schools (e.g. CTS equipment)
- RancheView School will open in stages due to construction delays. K-2 will reside at the new school in September with the rest of the grades joining in January 2017
- Fireside School principal will be Thomas Elbel (currently at Manachaban). Slated to open in September 2017
- Don Hoium announced his retirement commencing at the end of August 2016. A new superintendent will be hired with the hope that there is some transition/overlap with Don
- Expect provincial budget to be released next week
- Approved a change to the school calendar for 2016 the last day of school for high schools is June 29 rather than June 28 due to the government scheduling of a Grade 9 PAT and a Grade 12 diploma exam on June 28. K-8 will finish June 28
- 2017-2020 Capital plan approved. Year 2 will see an addition built at BVHS to increase capacity to 1,000 students

9. New Business

i) ASCA Conference & AGM - April 22-24, 2016 (Edmonton) - Discuss 5 Resolutions

- 5 resolutions discussed and a decision made on how BVHS Council will vote:
 - #1 Consent as an addition to Alberta sexual education curriculum YES
 - #2 Visual resources related to provincial assessments NO

- #3 Individualized Program Plans (IPPs)/Instructional Support Plans (ISPs) and other outcome based tools ABSTAIN
- #4 LGBTQ access to information YES
- #5 Provincial Support for Transfer Station development in regionalized transportation systems NO
- Fiona will act as the proxy for BVHS Council
